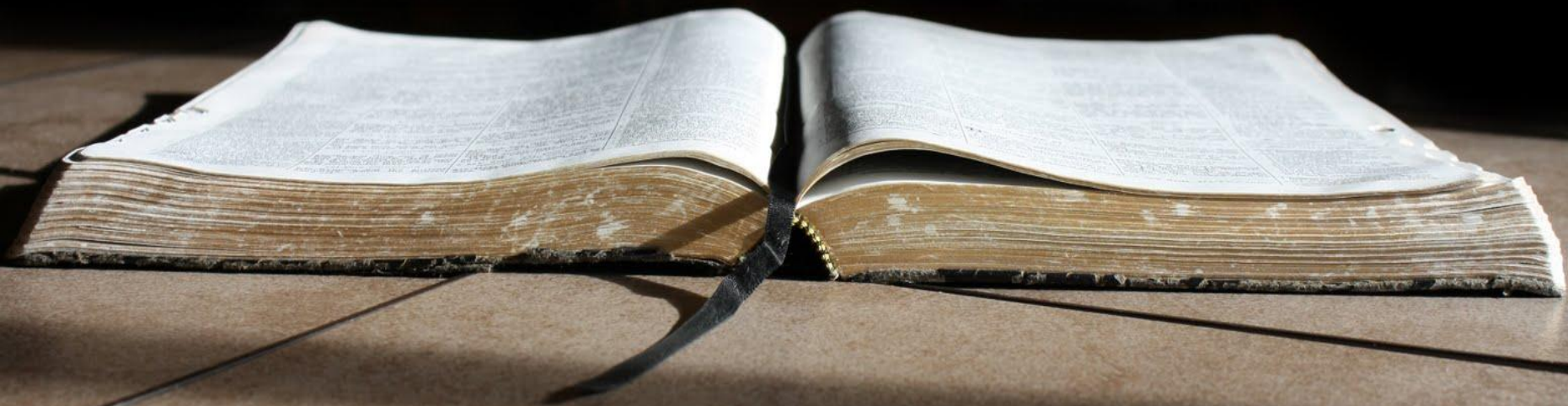




LOVE
