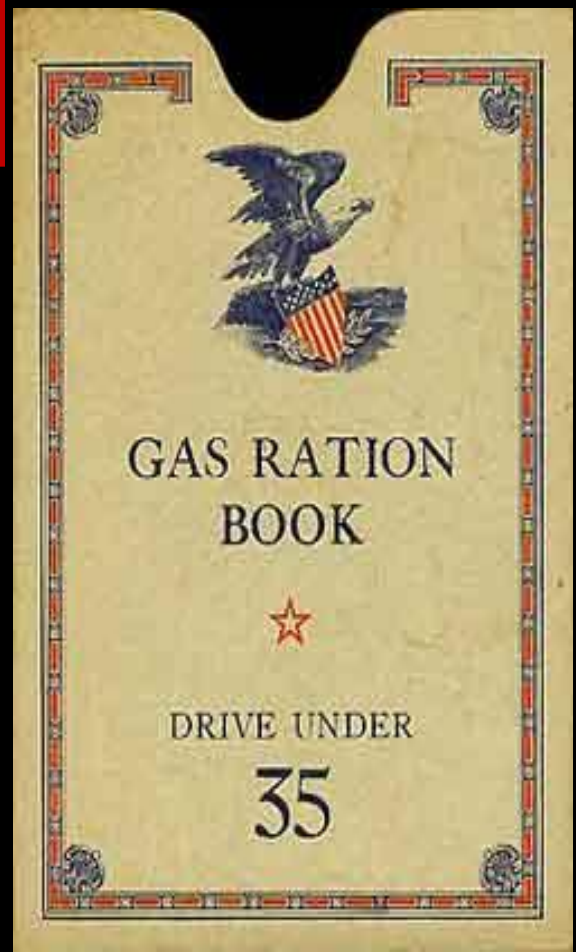

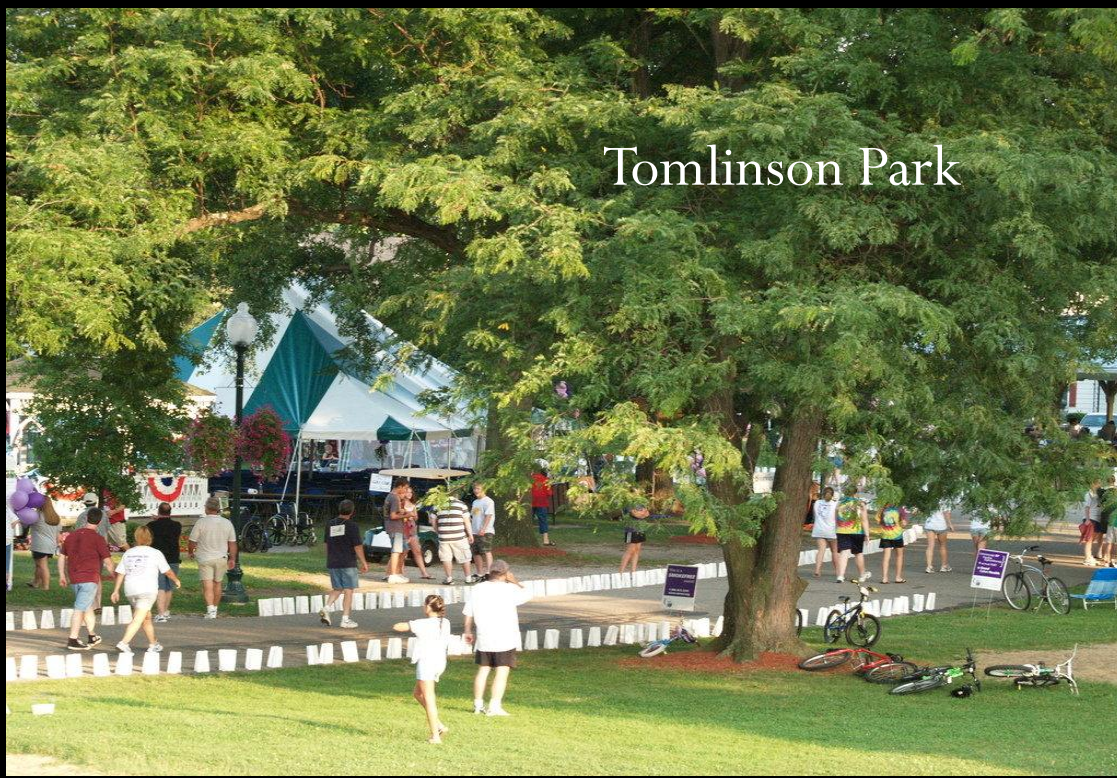

- ✓ Continued flooding
- ✓ City building ~ moved "up on the hill"
- ✓ Tomlinson Park ~ swimming pool, police and fire departments
 - ✓ Money collected ~ money returned
 - ✓ Pool remained ~ "water reservoir"
- ✓ City building and fire station built ~ 1947

- ✓ Fenton's donated volleyballs
 - ✓ Bleachers built
 - ✓ Tennis courts built
- ✓ Bicycles ~ gas rationing
- ✓ Tennis courts in yards
- ✓ No air conditioning
 - ✓ Basketball
- ✓ Population ~ 1930s and '40s ~ remained the same ~ 1,687
 - ✓ Home ~ street lights on





- ✓ Trolleys ~ every hour ~ Marietta and Parkersburg
 - ✓ 1947 discontinued
 - ✓ Old right-of-way visible across wetlands

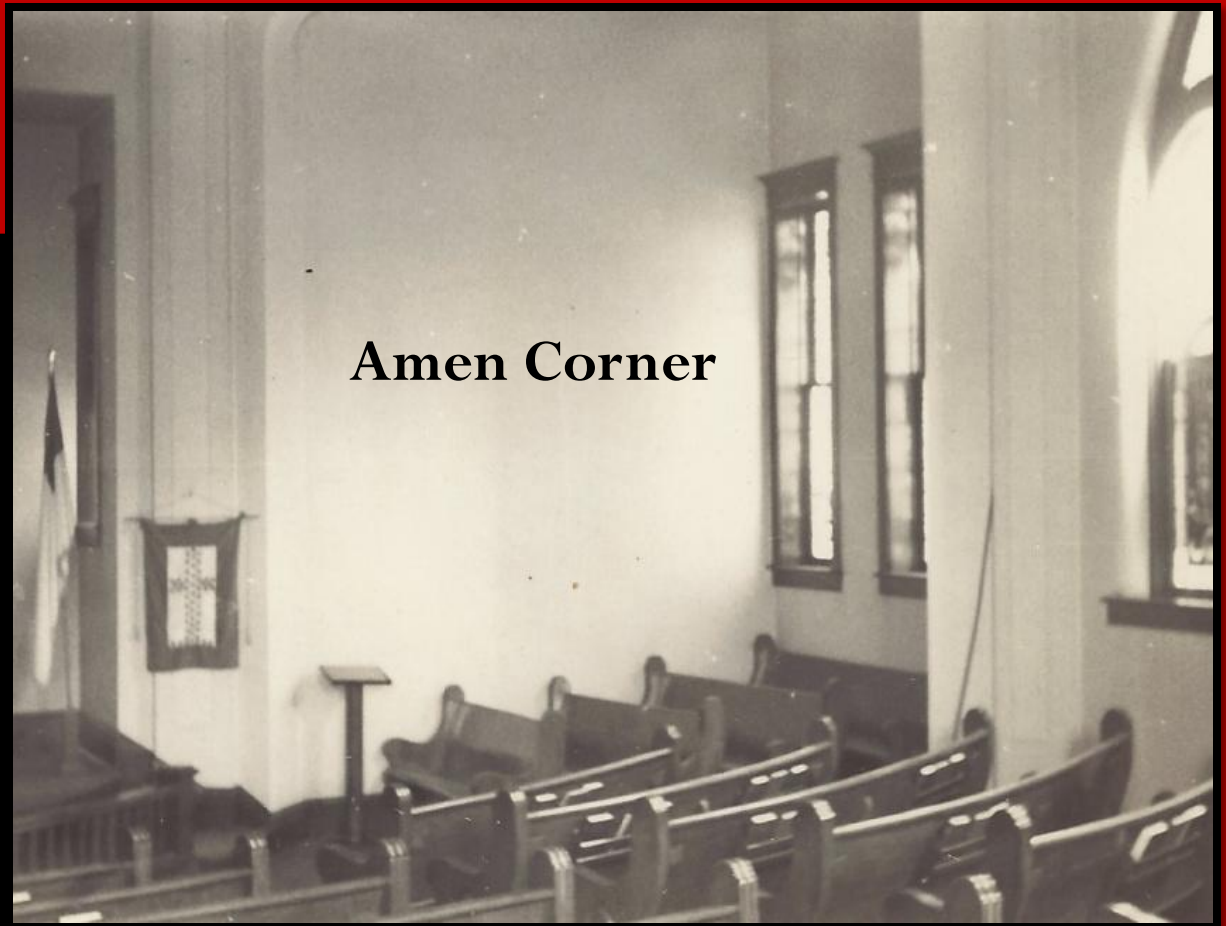
